Virginia Application of Peter Apperson VAS1062

Know all men by these presents that I Peter Apperson of the County of Spotsylvania, do hereby constitute & appoint William Nikervis Esqr of the City of Richmond my true & lawful attorney for me & on my behalf to receive from the Treasurer of the State of Virginia such pension as may be now due me, under the laws placing me on the pension list, hereby ratifying & confirming all such acts as my attorney may do in the premises

Witness my hand & seal this 5th day of August 1820 Peter hisXmark Apperson

NOTE: Two documents pertaining to Peter Apperson are in the online file of Daniel Anderson VAS1061 (00074 and 00075). The file of Peter Apperson contains several powers of attorney similar to the above, the last being dated 6 March 1834. In some of these documents Apperson is described as an “invalid pensioner,” but there are no details about his disability or service.
