




I do with the advice of Council hereby certify that Ferguson Hyland late a private in the line of this state and disabled in the service thereof is put on the Pension list by virtue of an act of the General Assembly "for allowing pensions to sundry persons therein mentioned," passed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1791, with an allowance of then pounds yearly, commencing on the day of the passage of said Act.

Given under my hand as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia at Richmond this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 1793. Henry Lee

NOTE: The file contains many documents similar to the next-to-last one above, as well as receipts signed by Hyland with his initials. Payment was ordered in Jefferson County after 1801, the year in which that county was formed from Berkeley County. The last document is an order for payment issued by the February 1806 court.
