John Aldridge a Soldier in Capt Uriah Springers [pension application R10017] Comp'y of the 9<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regim't who was enlisted to serve the term of three years in the Continental Army and has served out his time as a good & faithfull Soldier and is now Entitled to his discharge & is hereby discharged accordingly. given under my hand at Fort Pitt the 19 day of March 1780


