Westmoreland County State of Virginia ToWit

Be it known that Before me Robert Bailey A Justice of the peace in and for the county aforesaid personally appeared Job Self aged 68 years and made oath in due form of law that he was acquainted with Thomas Beale and knows that the said Thomas Beale enlisted in the early part of the Revolutionary under capt. Richard Barnet for and during the War and further knows that he was in actual service for several years until he was ordered to the north and in consequence of never hearing from him since have Reason to suspect and do verily believe that the said Beale was either slain in Battle or died in the Army Given under my hand this 12 may 1831
