

Tucker Best Sergeant in 1st Virginia State Reg't Having Served as A True & Faithful Soldier in Capt Hofflers [William Hoffler S38047] Company the Term of Three Years for which he was Enlisted is hereby Discharg'd from the Same given under my hand at Philidelphia. December 23rd 1779
