I do Certify that David Brookes a Soldier in Colo. Gists [Nathaniel Gist BLWt1874-500] Detachment of the Virg'a Line has Servd. the full term for which he was Inlisted & is hereby Discharg'd from the Service, that he has rec'd his pay in Continental Currency up to the last of November One thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Nine Since which he has rec'd only two Dollars in Specie from the D. Comsy Gen'l [Deputy Commissary General] of Prisoners, at Cha's Town [Charleston SC].

Given Under my hand at Williamsburg the 25th Day of July 1781.




