

These are to Certify that Robert Carter Formerly a Serjeant in the 1<sup>st</sup>[?] Virginia Regiment has duly and faithfully served the term of three years for which he was Inlisted in Consequence of which and at his own request he is hereby Discharged from any further service in the Army of the united states and [illegible] to return his home free & unmolested he haveing received all his Bounty pay and Cloathing & Deficiencies of pay & Cloathing in full of all allowances & provision [several undeciphered words] Congress for their Troops [several undeciphered words] which is on the Back hereof.

Given under my hand at Philidelphia this 4<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y 1780
