I do certify that Samuel Cobbs entered the Service of the United States in the Second Virginia Regiment on Continental Establishment either in the month of August or September, one thousand seven hundred and Seventy five and was afterward promoted to the Rank of Lieutenant, in which capacity he continued a considerable time, but am unable to state how long. Given under my hand this 26 of July 1807.
