York County, Sc.

I do hereby certify, that Benjamin Creedle and William Creedle, this day enlisted under Sam'l
Crawley [R13467], Lieut. in the artillery, belonging to the Commonwealth, for the term of three years,
they having taken the oath prescribed by the General Assembly of Virginia, and rec'd the bounty money
this 6th day of Sep'r 1777. William Graves

Benjamin & Wm. Creedle, enlisted Sep'r 6th 1777; Ben died Nov'r following; and William died March,
1780. Sam'l Crawley, Capt

At a Court held for York County, the 20th day of October, 1783.

On motion of Benjamin Creedle, who made oath thereto, and together with William Eaton his
security, entered into and acknowledged Bond as the Law directs, Certificates are granted him for
obtaining letters of administration on the estates of Benjamin Creedle and William Creedle, deceased, in
due form (a Copy) Teste, Wm. Russell D.C.Y

I do hereby Certify, that William Creedle, a soldier in the State Regiment of Artillery, and died
the first day of March 1783 G. Johnston, Cap'n [George Johnston]
Oct'r 30th 1784.

I do hereby Certify, that William Creedle, a soldier in the state reg't of Artillery, died the first of
March, 1780 Sam'l Crawley, Late Capt. s'd Reg.
Test/ Rob. Sandford. Oct'r 30th 1784

NOTE: At the time of William Creedle's death, the Virginia State Artillery Regiment was in Charleston
SC under siege by the British.
