City of Richmond To Wit

Peter Dean this day personally appeared before me the subscriber an Alderman for the said city, and made oath that he is the same Peter Dean referred to in the above certificate of the Auditor of Public Accounts and that he now resides in the County of Powhatan

Given under my hand this 9th day of Dec'r[?] 1820 James Rawlings

Powhatan County Towit.

John Deane this day personally appeared before me the subscriber A justice of the peace for said county and made oath that the within named Peter Deane, enlisted in the year 1776 for the term of three years, in a company commanded by George Nicholas in the 2nd Virginia [Continental] Regiment, and served the said term in the northern Army
