Caroline County to Wit

This day John Dunn personally appeared before me a Justice of the peace for said County and made oath that his brother James Dunn enlisted in the Army of the United States during the Revolutionary War, and that the said James Dunn died during the said War in the City of Richmond in the service of said United States. Given under my hand this 5th day of January 1811.

366 Essex S't Thomas May [possibly S38175] of King & Queen County a Soldier in the Revol'y War personally appeared me before & being examined on Oath declares that that the said James Dunn mentioned in the above certificate did die in the Cit of Richmond in the service of the United States & before the War was ended, & that the said James Dunn was a Brother of Joshua Dunn, & that the said Joshua Dunn was heir at law of the said James Dunn. Given under my hand this 31st day of July 1813.

Caroline County to wit

This day Jacob Daniel [VAS3262] personally appeared before me a Justice of The peace for the s'd County and made oath that James Dunn enlisted in the Army of the united states during the Revolutionary War, and that the said James Dunn died during the said war in the City of Richmond in the service of the United States. Given under my hand this 8th day of July 1813

James J Garnett

Caroline County July 15th 1813

I do Certify that John Dunn [undeciphered word] of said County of Caroline had several sons in the last Revolutionary War, and his son by the name of James died in the service of said War, Joshua Dunn who was a Soldier in the [two or three undeciphered words] about the same time. A brother of said James was the Oldest son of s'd John Dunn dec'd.
