


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Virginia documents pertaining to Curtis Geddings (Giddens) VAS3695

[The following are from [rejected claims in the Library of Virginia](#) indexed as Geddings, Curtis. Curtis Geddings is probably the "Custis Geddings" mentioned in the rejected claim of John Bonwell (sic James Bonwell) VAS690.]

I do certify that Ismey Giddens [Isma Giddins VAS522] and Curtis Giddens are brothers (as I always understood) and that they were both in the ninth Virginia Regiment, on Continental establishment, in the war of the Revolution and that they both died in the said service, and that they were always said to be brothers to Ishmael Giddens
