
Winchester Barracks April 25th 1783

Certify that Isaac Glass enlisted in the Continental army for the term of three years that [undeciphered]
that [one or two undeciphered words] enlisted since for the war [several undeciphered words]
2 iss'd Samuel Hawes [BLWt1066-450] Lt. Colo

Glass enlisted in March 1777 for three years after serving three years successively he reenlisted for the
war in May 1780. A Kirkpatrick Capt [Abraham Kirkpatrick BLWt1210-300]
