Virginia Pension Application of James Curry VAS671

To all to whom these present shall come.

Know ye that I have constituted and appointed, & by these presents, do constitute and appoint John Cantrill Esq'r. now a member of the Assembly of Virginia my attorney in fact for the express purpose of drawing and conveying to me a pension granted me by the State of Virginia of five pounds per annum and payable I believe on the 15<sup>th</sup> of January yearly. – on the ensueing January there will be I think four years due to which time Mr. Cantrill to draw.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Columbus. Franklin County State of Ohio Ss.

Personally appeared before me the within mentioned James Curry and acknowledged this his power of attorney to John Cantrill Esq'r. for the purposes therein mentioned.

NOTE: The file contains several powers of attorney similar to the above, renewed annually, the last one being dated 30 Jan 1833. None of the documents in the file contains any information about Curry's service.
