Bounty Land Warrant of Thomas Edmunds BLWt997-300  
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

VA

Sussex County [VA] to wit, See Officers books February Court 1821  
Ordered that it be certified that John Edmunds dec'd. was the sole and only heir of Capt. Thomas Edmunds of the Virginia line in the revolutionary war and that Thomas W. R. Edmunds, Jack B. F. Edmunds, Martha E. M. J. Edmunds, Edwin S. Edmunds and Edward R. Edmunds are the children and only heirs of the late Major John Edmunds dec'd. A Copy Teste Jas. Bailey Clk.

Fayette County [KY] towit December Court 1820.  
Frederick Ridgley is appointed Guardian to William Randolph Edmunds, Jack Bathurst Frederick Edmunds, Martha Eliza Mary Jane Edmunds Edward Randolph Edmunds and Edwin Short Edmunds infant orphans of John Edmunds deceased, under the age of fourteen years, who executed bond in the penal sum of Thirty thousand dollars with Peyton Short and Charles Wilkins his securities conditioned as the Law directs

I do Herby Certifie that Thos. Edmunds was a Captain in the 15<sup>th</sup> Virginia Reigm't. in the Continental Army and march'd from Williamsburg in March 1777 and that he Continued in the Army During the War I also Certifie that John Edmunds is his Lawfull & Legal Heir, Given under my hand this 20<sup>th</sup> day Sept'r 1809. I well know that Capt Thos. Edmunds entered the Military Service of the United States in the Revolutionary War, in the 15 Virg'a Regim't., early in the year 1777 but at what time he rec'd. his Commission (the time when his remuneration should commence) it is impossible for me to say; perhaps that can be ascertained from the Court of his County. The termination of his services is sufficiently ascertain'd
