



No. 11059 and I have no other evidence except my own Oath and what has already been furnished their war department my Family consists of myself aged as aforesaid a shoemaker without having learned the trade my Daughter Mary in her 26<sup>th</sup> year afflicted by a canser or some other disease of that kind so as to be a perfect charge L[?] in her 16<sup>th</sup> year healthy and able to support herself and in persuance of an act the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 1820 I do solemnly swear that I was a resident Citizen of the United States on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to bring myself within the provisions of an act of Congress entitled "an act to provide for certain person engaged in the land and naval service of the United States in the Revolutionary War" passed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1818 and that I have not nor has any person in trust for me any property or securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than what is contained in the Schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed.
