

[p 6: Printed form of Indent No. 446 Book N dated April 9th, 1785, “delivered to Mr. Henry Harrison this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Two Pounds fourteen Shillings and three Pence farthing Sterling for 38 days duty as a Private in the Militia in 17[last two digits obliterated] as per Account Audited.”]

[p 7: Reverse of the above Indent bearing, among others, the following endorsement:

I do Assign over unto Mich'l Russel the Contents of the within Indent being Two pounds fourteen Shillings & three pence farthing. Witness my hand this 26 August 1785
