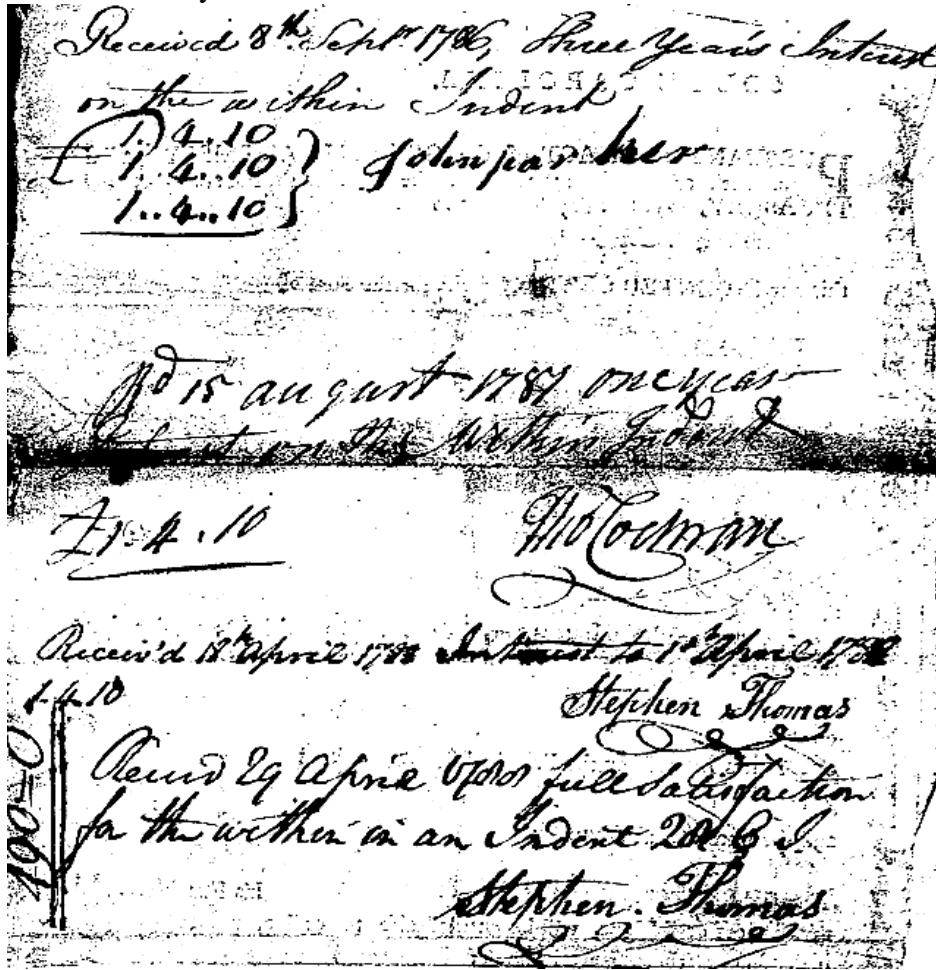

[p 2: Printed form of Indent No. 490 Book O dated April 23, 1785 “delivered to Mr. Charles Herd this our INDENTED CERTIFICATE for the Sum of Seventeen Pounds, fifteen Shillings & eight Pence, half penny, Sterling, for Militia Duty from 1779 to 1783 as Private & Lieutenant, per Account Audited.”]

[p 3: Reverse of the above Indent bearing endorsements by Thomas Parker, Thomas Cochran, and Stephen Thomas but none by the veteran. How these men acquired an interest in the indent is not disclosed by the documents in this file.
