[Note: The veteran was granted an Indent No. 394 Book P dated April 30, 1785 for £69.5.7 which amount included compensation for service for 31 days as Commissary for General Francis Marion's brigade commencing September 28, 1781. The file does not contain the veteran's signature. The veteran was deceased by September 1, 1785 at which time his executor, Thomas Henning, signed an order for the indents due Joseph Henning to be delivered to James Shackelford. The following is the signature of Thomas Henning:

. Most of the amount awarded to the veteran was for provisions and money provided for military use as well as for ferriage.]
